Subject: Detailed Note on Charitable Activities in the Field of Education for Registration under Section 12AB of the Income Tax Act, 1961.

❖ Introduction:

Navbihan Sewa Society is a charitable organization registered under the Societies Registration Act 21, 1860. The society's registered office is located at Naina Sevak Kutir, Ward No. 13 (Bullechak), Jitwarpur Nizamat, Samastipur – 848134.

The primary mission of the society is to bring about everlasting change among marginalized communities to improve their quality of life and eliminate social inequalities. As per its constitution, the society is dedicated to strengthening the economic capacities and capabilities of these communities while ensuring they receive their genuine entitlements from government bodies.

The society's core objectives and activities are broadly classified into the following key domains:

- **Educational Advancement:** Focusing on promoting adult literacy, providing formal and vocational education to the socially and educationally marginalized, and supporting deserving students.
- **Healthcare Services:** Organizing health education, vaccination camps (such as Pulse Polio), eye camps, and awareness programs for major health concerns like AIDS, Cancer, and Tuberculosis.
- **Community & Rural Development:** Working for the all-round development of rural and urban poor, including widows, senior citizens, and persons with disabilities, by providing essential needs like shelter and drinking water.
- **Social Reform & Environment:** Actively working to eradicate social evils like dowry and child marriage while promoting environmental protection through plantation programs and non-conventional energy awareness.

All income and properties of the society are applied solely toward the promotion of these charitable aims and objects, ensuring that no portion is distributed as profit or dividends to its members.

❖ Primary Educational Activities Undertaken (Establishment of Bullechak Bal Vikas Kendra)

The Society has established a “*Bullechak Bal Vikas Kendra*” at Bullechak, Samastipur, which is a free play-based learning centre for young children.

The centre was formally inaugurated on 28/11/2023 in the presence of local MLA and a large gathering of villagers, reflecting strong community participation and acceptance. The function was graced by Dr. Sharad Kumari, State Coordinator, Action Aid Association, Patna, as Chief Guest, and Smt. Nivedita Banerjee, Founder Secretary and former official of SBI Nai Dharti NGO, Bihar.



The Society is running the centre in alignment with the National Education Policy (NEP), 2020, particularly focusing on the Foundational Stage of education.

- The centre caters to children of 3+, 4+, and 5+ age groups (Pre-Nursery / Balvatika).
- The program follows activity-based and play-based learning methods.
- Primary focus is on developing foundational literacy and numeracy skills.
- The medium of instruction is mother tongue (Hindi) along with exposure to basic spoken English.

The Society is providing completely free educational facilities to children without charging any fees. All operational and administrative costs of the centre are being borne entirely by the Society, and no funding or grant is received from the Government.



The Society has developed a dedicated learning environment for children, including:

- Classroom facilities with educational charts and learning materials
- Play-based learning equipment such as slides and activity tools
- Safe and child-friendly premises for holistic development

The focus is on creating a supportive, engaging, and inclusive environment for early childhood education.

The establishment of the centre has contributed to:

- Increasing awareness about early childhood education in the local community
- Encouraging parents to enroll children in structured learning at an early age
- Supporting overall social development at the grassroots level

❖ Organization of Blood Donation Camp and Free Health Check-up Camp:

The Society organized a Blood Donation Camp along with a General Health Check-up Camp on 17th April 2023 at its premises, with the objective of promoting public health and supporting medical needs of the community.

The event witnessed active participation from the local community, wherein 34 voluntary blood donors (Raktaveers), including one female donor, donated blood for noble causes such as medical emergencies, surgeries, and accident cases. Notably, the camp also saw participation from qualified medical professionals, including doctors holding MBBS, MD, and Homeopathy qualifications, which added credibility and encouragement to the initiative.



In addition to blood donation, the Society conducted free health check-ups for more than 100 individuals, including a significant number of women. The health check-up included basic diagnostic tests such as blood pressure, blood sugar, and general health assessment, aimed at early detection and prevention of diseases.

❖ Educational Tour for Foundational Stage Children:
